INVITATION TO TAKE THE TEST

The deadline for the participation to the Sustainability Literacy Test had been extended to **23 October**. 3 new sessions open!

Dear Students,

As you are aware, your College/University is deeply involved in sustainable development. We are pleased to tell you that we decided to engage the institution further by taking part in an international initiative: the <u>Sustainability Literacy Test</u>. This test is a tool to assess and verify the sustainability literacy of students. It assesses the minimum level of knowledge in economic, social and environmental responsibility for higher education students all over the world.

- This is an online test. Thirty minutes are usually needed for the test.
- A single correct answer is possible for each question.
- A correct answer gives one point. An incorrect response or "I do not know" gives 0 point.
- Please note that you cannot change an answer once validated.

1. Creating an Account

Before starting, you will have to create a student account: http://www.thesustainabilityliteracytest.org/en/visitor/studentaccount/create

We recommend creating your student account before the session begins to avoid eating in to the time needed for the test. To create your account will need your session number (see above) and your personal student ID. [For instance, for the Student Alexander Smith you could use ASMITH2014). Please note that this ID is important as it's the only way for you to link a score to a specific student]

You will also have to choose a password. Your password is unique. Please keep it carefully; it allows you to have access to your session and to your score. Note that your student account allows you to restart the test if you have left it (in the limits of the timeslot).

Getting a high score shows you have the minimum knowledge that we all need to help solve societal problems. If you do not get many of the answers correct, remember this awareness can help you improve your knowledge to participate more effectively in solutions.
